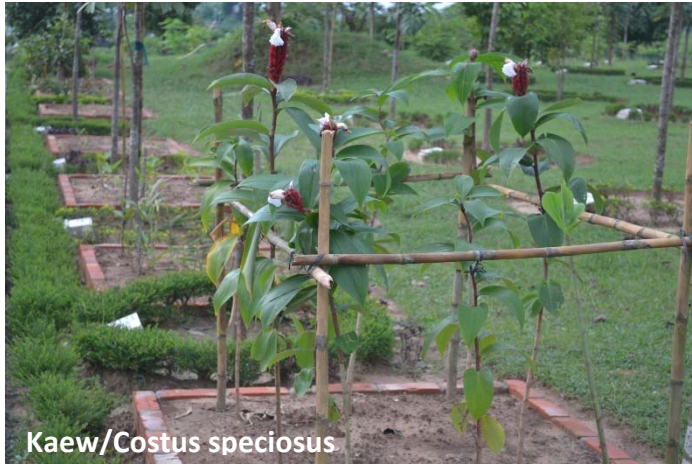

Medicinal Plant Garden

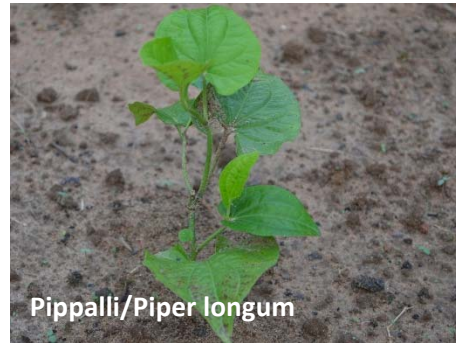
Agroforestry and Medicinal Plant development is one of the major components of Project. In order to conserve the germ plasm (ex-situ Conservation) the Project has

developed a “Medicinal Plant Garden” within the ‘Smtiti-van’ located at Project Management Unit (PMU) complex, Hatipara, Gandhigram. Some of the important species planted in the Medicinal Plant Garden include Aswaganga,

Rouwolfia serpentina, Pandanus latifolia, Costus speciosus, Bach, Kalamegh, Aloe vera, Vanilla, Pippali, etc. The Medicinal Plants Garden of the Tripura JICA Project boasts of 120 species of medicinal trees, herbs, shrubs and climbers. This is the largest medicinal plant collection at a single site in Tripura.
